Hope, peace, and love are all inner qualities that we cultivate, but joy can motivate us to celebrate outwardly. It can overflow out of us to express itself in our: <u>worship</u>, <u>words</u> and <u>wants</u>. 2 Samuel 6 shows this happening to David.

Last week we spoke of advent themes: <u>hope</u> & <u>peace</u>.

Advent Theme #3: JOY

In Biblical terms, having joy means being happy & rejoicing that something good that has arrived or is coming. It has a long-term view of life, emphasizing the good that will come from the Lord, despite present circumstances.

How does joy relate to Christmas?

- Luke 1:14, He will be a joy & delight to you, and many will rejoice because of his birth.
- Is that your experience with Jesus? That He is a "joy & delight"?
- Nehemiah 8:10, ...the joy of the Lord is your strength.

If not, here are three truths about biblical joy to focus on. We have...

#1 JOY ETERNAL:

- Jesus was born to save us: <u>Matthew 1:21</u>, *She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins.*
- Angels celebrate: <u>Luke 15:10</u>, *There is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over 1 sinner who repents.*
- Sin dampens joy: <u>Psalm 51:12</u>, Restore to me the joy of your salvation & grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.
- If you believe this, it can reflect itself in how you worship (express yourself sincerely when you praise God).

#2 JOY IN TRIAL:

- <u>James 1:2-3</u>, "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance."
- Even if it leads to pain: <u>Luke 6:23</u>, *Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in heaven.* For that is how their ancestors treated the prophets.
- Pray with big faith: <u>John 16:24</u>, *Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask & you will receive, & your joy will be complete.*
- If you believe this, it can reflect itself in your words (let your heart overflow from your mouth about good news).

#3 JOY TODAY:

- Go to God for satisfaction: Psalm 94:19, When anxiety was great within me, your consolation brought me joy.
- Find joy in being in God's presence: <u>Psalm 16:11</u>, You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.
- Let the Holy Spirit do a work from the inside out: <u>Galatians 5:22</u>, ...the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace...
- If you believe this, it can reflect itself in your wants (find more desire in godly things and less in the world).
