Genesis 2:1-17 provides us a FOUNDATION FOR THE GOOD LIFE.

# God Rested and Designed Us to Rest (Genesis 2:1-3)

#### *1*. God rested to reveal His nature to us:

- He is perfect so he stopped because nothing could be improved.
- He is joyful and delights in His creation.
- $\circ$  He is relational and invites us to rest with Him.

#### 2. God rested to model a rhythm we desperately need:

- "Then he said to them, 'The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath.'" (Mark 2:27)
- "*Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.*" (*Exodus 20:8*)
- "Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day." (<u>Colossians 2:16</u>)
- Text REST to (951)425-4425 to learn about a modern sabbath rest.

#### 3. God rested to give us a picture of salvation. Jesus is our sabbath rest:

- "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (<u>Matthew 11:28-30</u>)
- "There remains, then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God." (<u>Hebrews 4:9</u>)

## God Lives and Gives Us Life (Genesis 2:4-14)

- 1. Life is a gift, not a guarantee. Value life from the unborn, to people with disabilities, to the elderly!
- 2. Our value comes from who made us, not what we do.
- 3. As image bearers, we are called to reflect God.

## God Worked and Called Us to Work (Genesis 2:15)

- 1. Work is God's design, not a punishment. It was "pre-fall".
- 2. Your workplace is one of your best mission fields.
  - "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." (<u>Matthew 28:19-20</u>)
- *3*. Work with excellence as a reflection of Christ:
  - "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters." (Colossians 3:23)

### God Chose and Gives Us a Choice (Genesis 2:16-17)

- 1. Love requires that we are free to choose what we want.
  - "You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love." (*Galatians 5:13*)
- 2. God didn't have to create us or save us, but He chose to:
  - "For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless..." (*Ephesians 1:4*)
  - "The Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world." (<u>Revelation 13:8</u>)

So now it's up to everyone to choose to follow Him once for our salvation and to choose to daily follow Jesus as Lord.
