Let's walk the road to redemption together and discover the signposts Jesus left for us during Holy Week.

SUNDAY: The Signpost of Surrender

Matthew 21:8-9, "A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road. The crowds that went ahead of him and those that followed shouted, 'Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest heaven!'"

- Our faith becomes fickle when based on personal expectations rather than God's plan.
- The problem isn't with God's faithfulness but with our misaligned expectations.

MONDAY: The Signpost of Purification

Matthew 21:12-13, "Jesus entered the temple courts and drove out all who were buying and selling there. He overturned the tables of the money changers and the benches of those selling doves. 'It is written,' he said to them, 'My house will be called a house of prayer, but you are making it a den of robbers.'"

- 1 Corinthians 6:19-20, "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own..."
- Psalm 51:10, "Create in me a pure heart, O God..."
- We must allow Jesus to examine all areas of our heart with the same scrutiny He gave the temple.

TUESDAY: The Signpost of Readiness

Matthew 24:42, "Therefore keep watch, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come."

- Readiness isn't about knowing when Jesus will return, but living faithfully until He does.
- Living with eternal perspective means making choices in light of Christ's return.

WEDNESDAY: The Signpost of Loyalty

Matthew 26:14-16, "Then one of the Twelve—the one called Judas Iscariot—went to the chief priests and asked, 'What are you willing to give me if I deliver him over to you?' So they counted out for him thirty pieces of silver. From then on Judas watched for an opportunity to hand him over."

- Mark 8:38, "Whoever is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of them when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels."
- Romans 1:16, "I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes..."
- Proximity to Jesus doesn't guarantee loyalty to Jesus.

THURSDAY: The Signpost of Humility

John 13:12-17, "When he had finished washing their feet, he put on his clothes and returned to his place. 'Do you understand what I have done for you?' he asked them. 'You call me "Teacher" and "Lord," and rightly so, for that is what I am. Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. Very truly I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. Now that you know...you will be blessed if you do them.'"

- The road to redemption leads us downward in humility before it leads us upward.
- Servanthood isn't occasional; it's the posture of those who walk the road of redemption.
