Question #3: Will I Say "Yes" to What God Asks? (Genesis 24:28-67)

Response to God's Call

- Will God finish what He's started? Abraham believed: Yes.
- Will God provide for what I'm facing? Eliezer experienced: Yes.
- Will I go when God calls? Rebekah answered: Yes.

Can we live that kind of "yes"? Even when we're waiting without knowing **when**, walking without knowing **where**, and believing without knowing **how**?
