### **How does one spend money wisely as a follower of Christ?**

Our spending does not happen in a vacuum.

### **1) Contentment is Learned, Not Found**

#### ***Philippians 4:11-12:***

*I am not saying this because I am in need, for I have learned to be content whatever the circumstances. / I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.*

**- Contentment does not come from having more. It comes from needing less**

## **2) Budgeting is a Spiritual Discipline**

***Matthew 6:21:***

*For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*

**- A budget is not about restriction; it is about formation. It helps you to say ‘Yes!’ to the better things and ‘No!’ to the lesser things.**

## **3) True Contentment Comes from the Giver, Not the Gift**

***Philippians 4:13:***

*I can do all this through him who gives me strength.*

**- Our lives should not matter around the things we want to get. Our lives should solely matter on pursuing after the Giver of all things.**
