Mark 4:35-41 (NIV)

- The greatest storms in our lives often reveal how small OR HOW BIG our view of Jesus really is
- James 1:2-4
- *"What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us."* — **A.W. Tozer**
- Fear often magnifies the storm in life...because it minimizes the Savior

Mark 5:6-13 (NIV)

- Jesus doesn't simply step into our lives to calm the storms around us; He steps into our lives to set us free from the bondage within us..
- Religion binds us to focusing on behavior modification, rather than focusing on Heart transformation

Mark 5:14-20 (NIV)

- Sometimes Jesus calms our storms, heals our hearts and we still miss him
- *"Christianity, if false, is of no importance, and if true, of infinite importance."* — **C.S. Lewis**
- You can spend your life around the presence of Jesus, but until you respond to Him, you'll always have religion without relationship
- Instead of only asking God to help you calm the storms or free you from circumstances this week... ask a deeper question: **How do you want me to respond to this, lord?**
