



Jesus Does Everything Well

Scripture: Mark 7:1-37

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"He has done everything well." - Mark 7:37

Main Idea: Mark 7 reveals the heart of Jesus. He confronts empty religion, honors humble faith, and restores broken people.

1. Jesus Confronts Religion - Mark 7:1-23

Key Truth: Religion can clean up the outside, but only Jesus can transform the heart.

Key Takeaways

- Jesus confronts empty religion.
- God's Word must always take priority over human tradition.
- Our greatest problem is not external but internal.
- We don't need cleaner hands. We need renewed hearts.

2. Jesus Honors Humble Faith - Mark 7:24-30

Key Truth: Jesus welcomes those who come to Him in humble faith.

Key Takeaways

- God welcomes outsiders who trust Him.
- Humble faith is greater than religious status.
- Faith expresses itself through intercessory prayer.
- We can faithfully bring others to Jesus through prayer.

3. Jesus Restores Broken People - Mark 7:31-37

Key Truth: Jesus doesn't simply perform miracles. He loves people.

Key Takeaways

- Jesus moves toward the broken.
- Jesus refuses to become a formula.
- Faith looks to Jesus before looking anywhere else.
- Jesus has done everything well.

2. What opinions, preferences, or traditions might I be holding onto more tightly than God's Word?
3. Who can I faithfully bring to Jesus in prayer this week?
